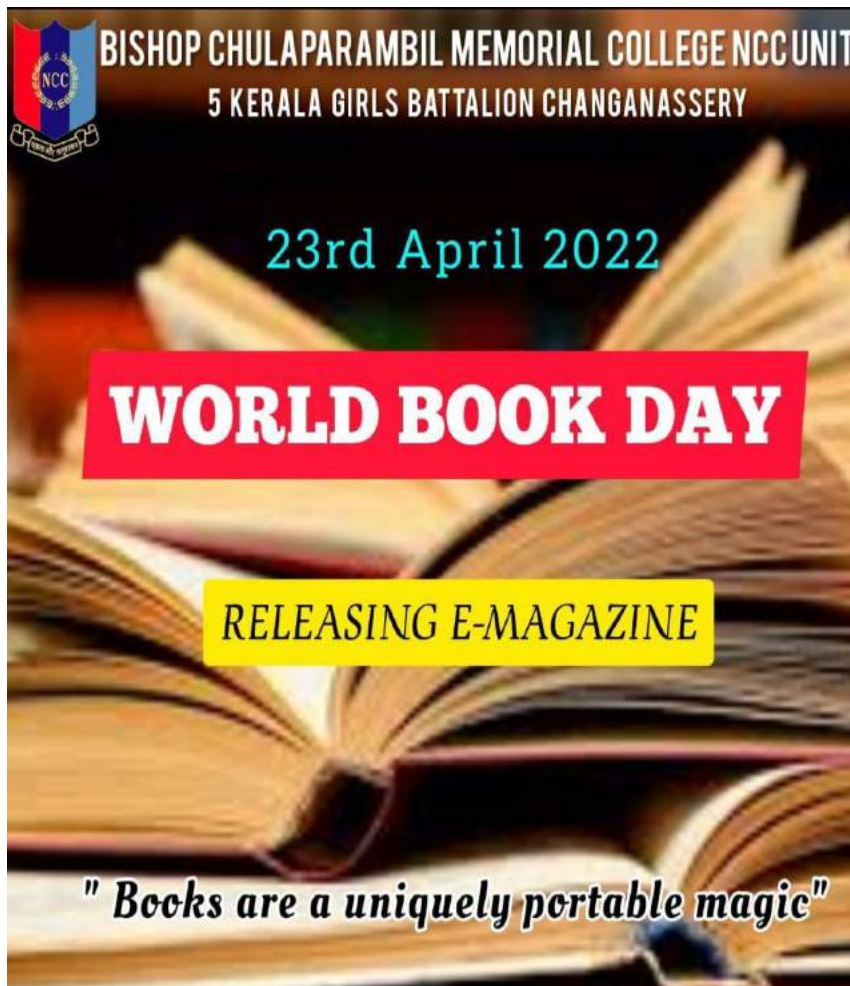
1.JALLIANWALA BAGH DAY

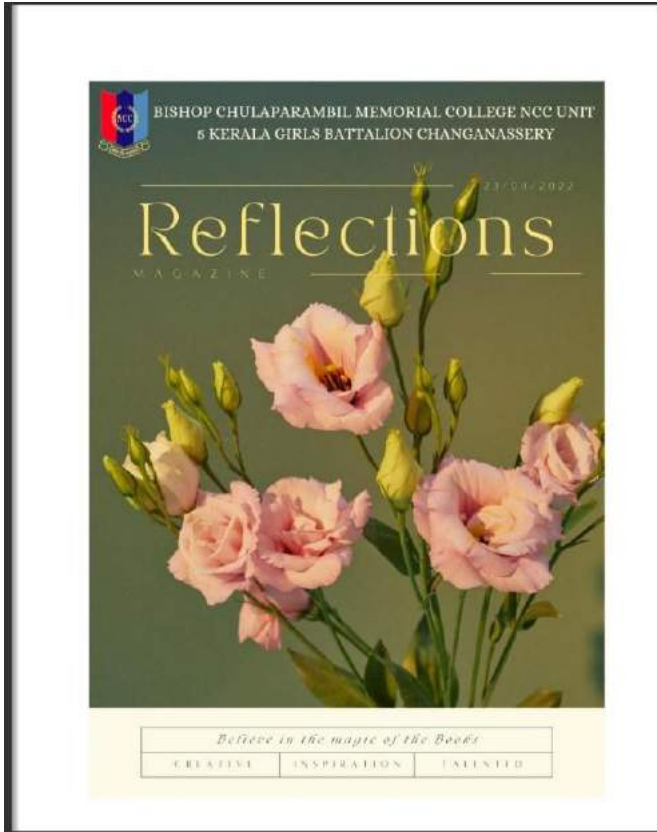
2.WORLD BOOK DAY

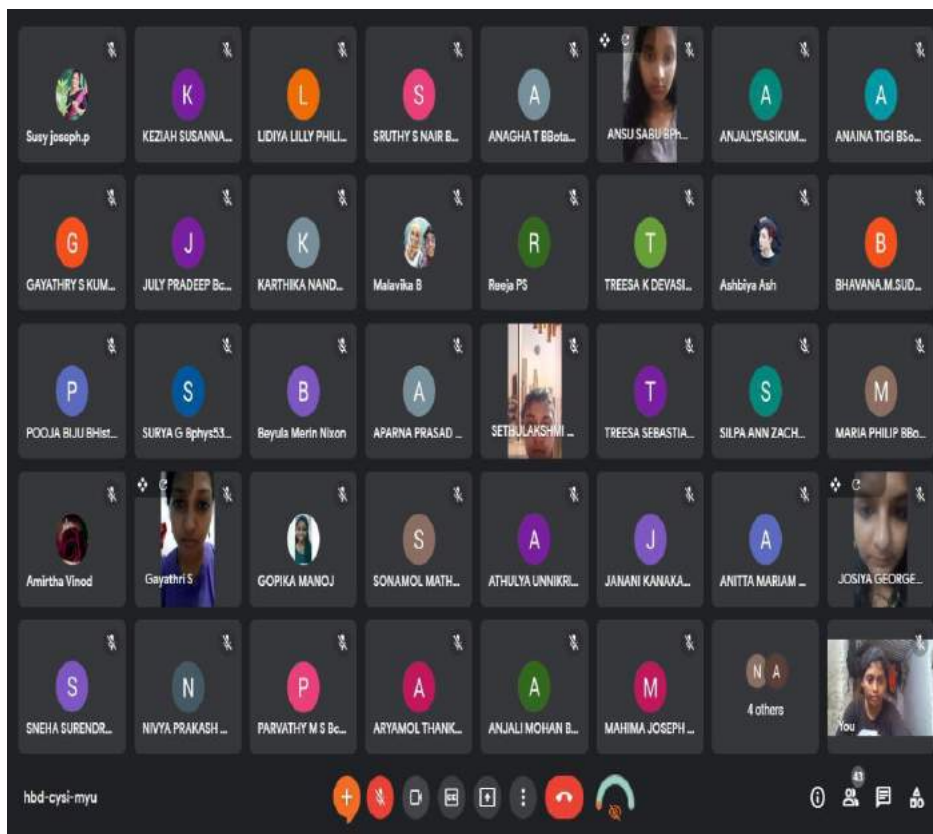
Topic : Protect the Environment

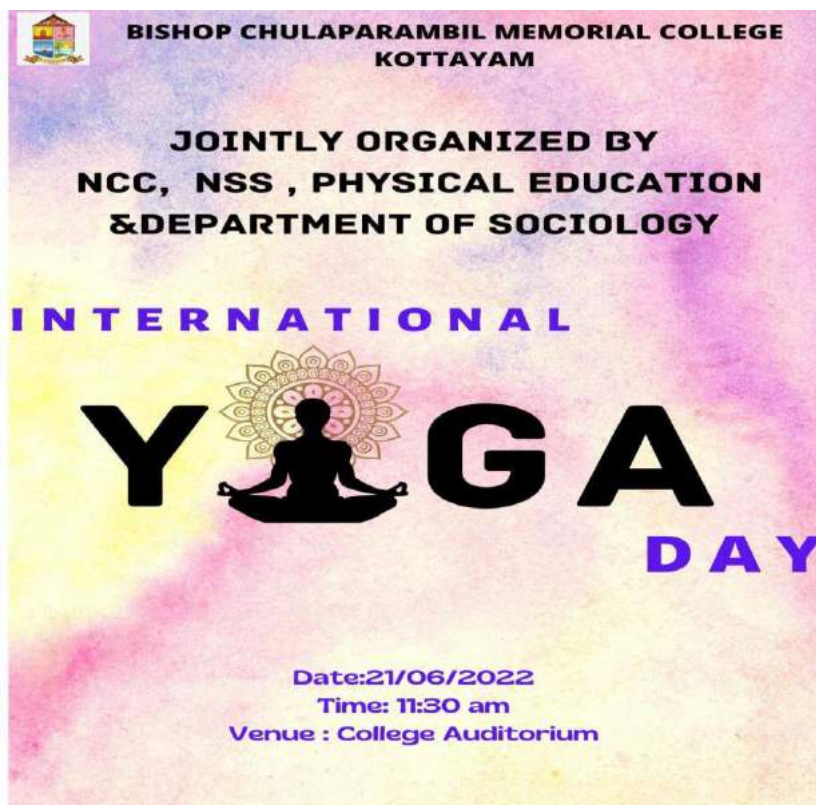

8.INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY



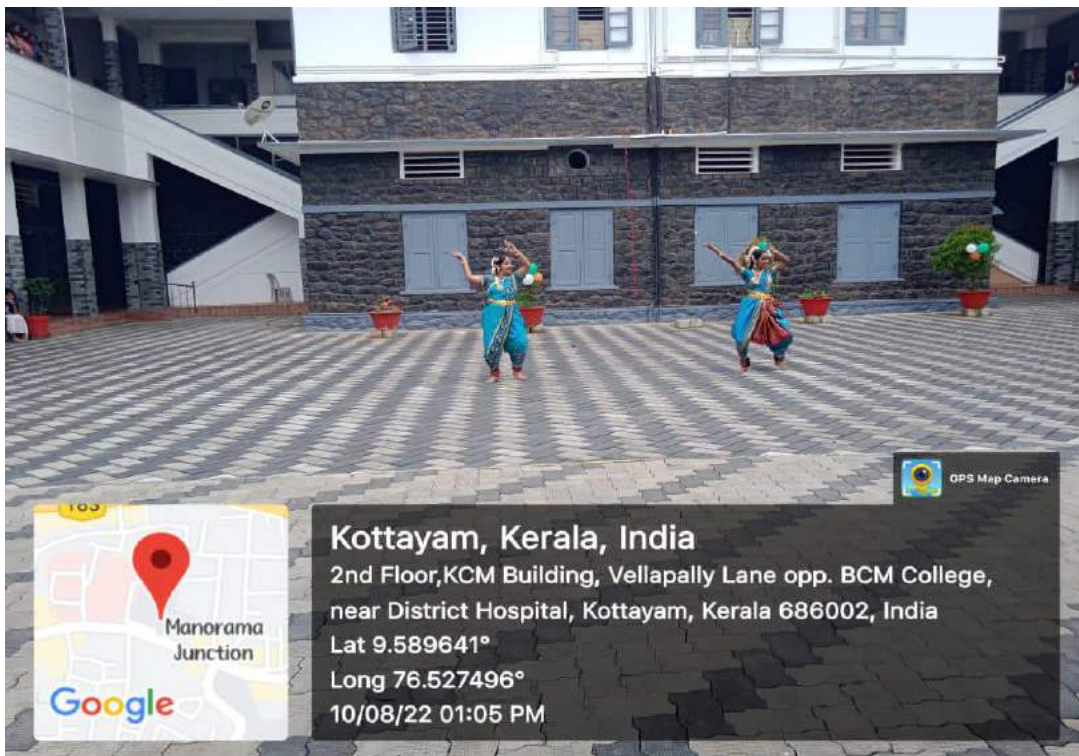
13.AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV

22.FOOD DRIVE



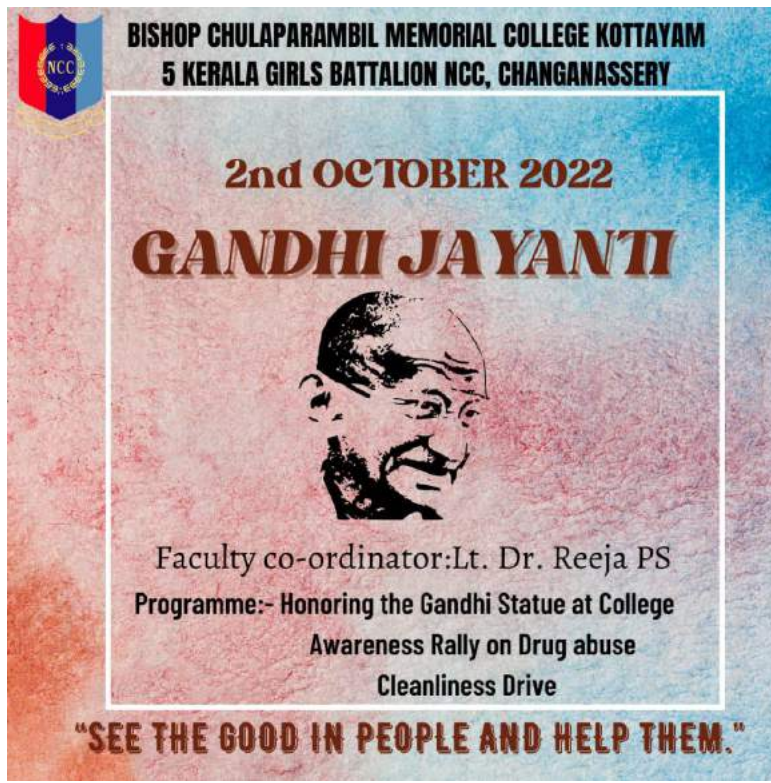

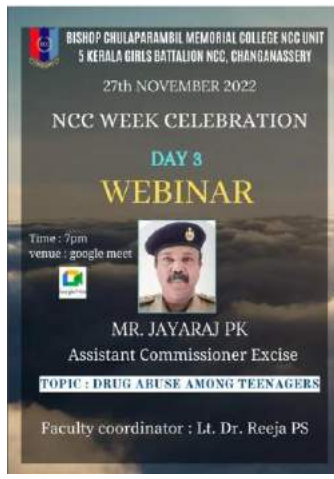
3.DEBATE COMPETITION

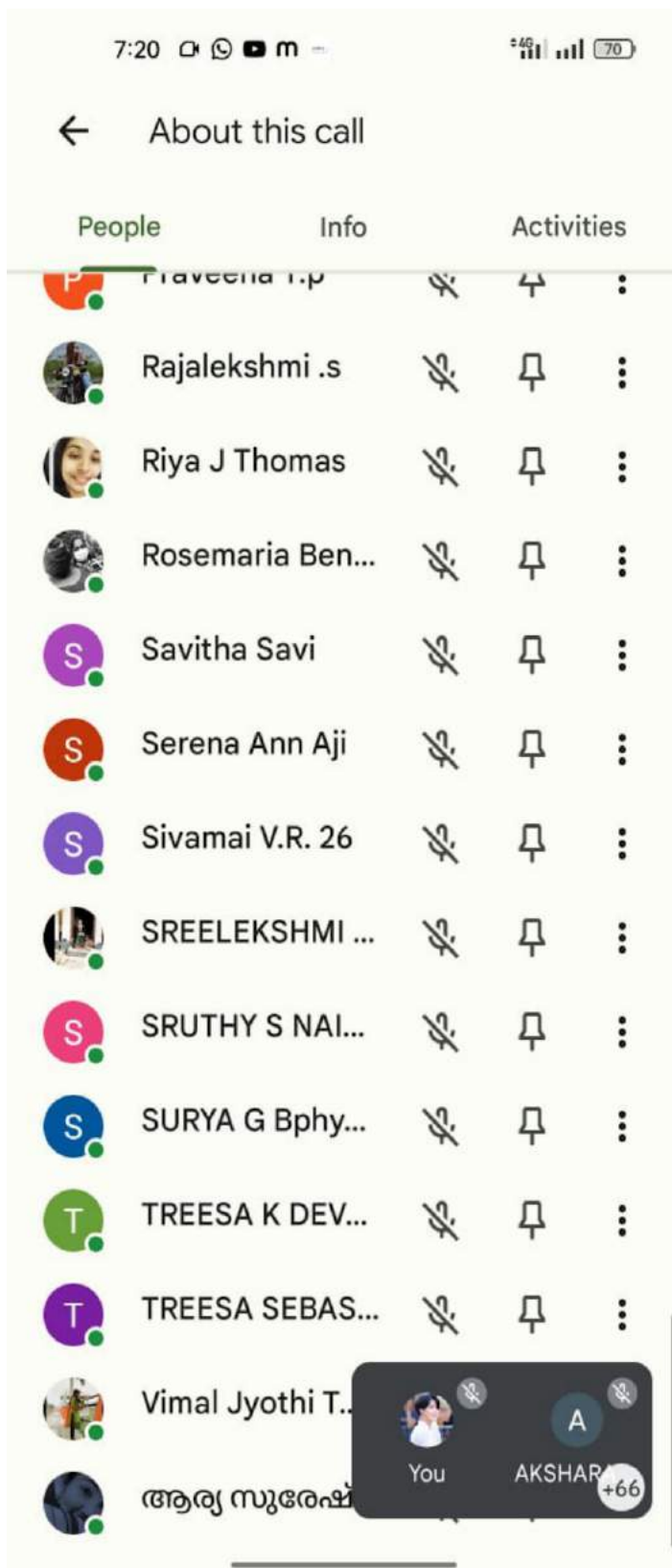

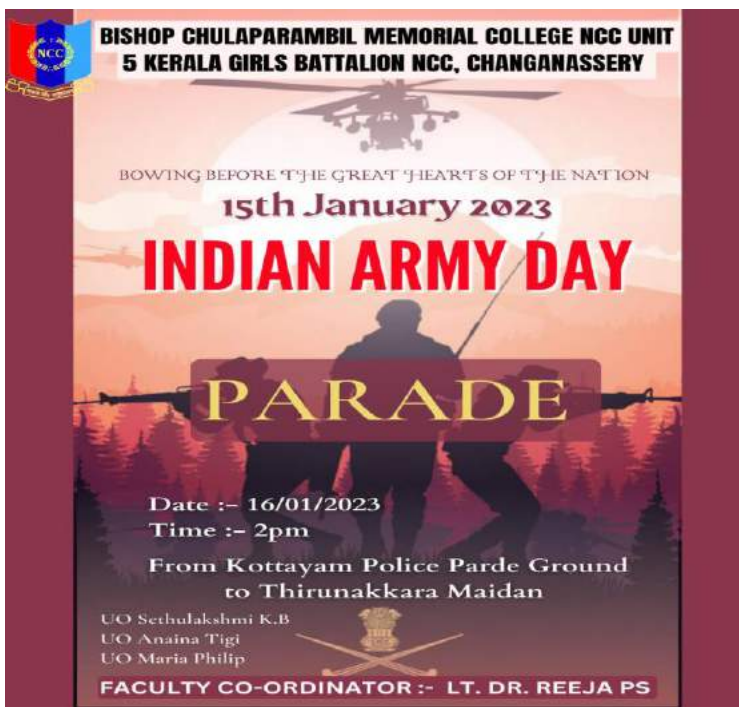

33.REPUBLIC DAY PARADE

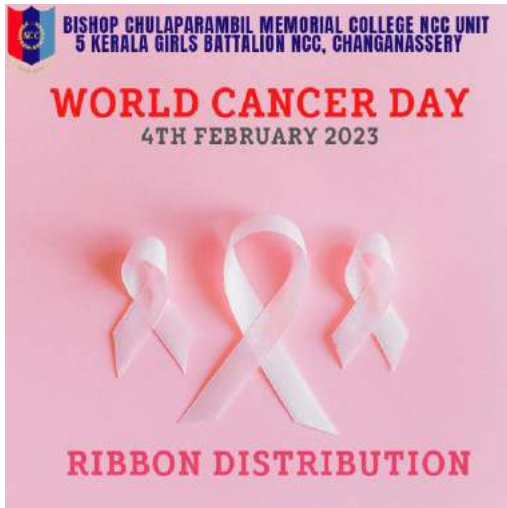


Republic Day is the day when India marks and celebrates the date on which the Constitution of India came into effect on 26 January 1950.
